References need not be included.

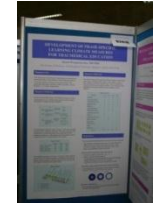

Instruction for Posters

1. The poster will be displayed on a panel board and should be designed to occupy an area of 0.8 metre high and 0.6 metre wide.

2. The poster layout should be designed to include:

- Title, authors, address (at the upper edge, across the width of the whole poster)
- Objectives
- Methods
- Results
- Conclusions

3. The text legends, graphs and illustrations should be easily read from a distance of 1.5m.

Please mount your poster for display from **0730 hrs on 15 Nov 2013**. Display your poster throughout the meeting and please remove it only after **1200 hrs on 17 Nov 2013**.

Velcro on the poster board will be provided. Please refer the Abstract Book (which will be given to you at the time of registration).

Information for Poster Presenters

Poster panel dimensions: 2m (height) X 1m (width).

Note: Effective space for mounting poster: 1.8 (height) X 0.9m (width).

Material of panel board: Felt finish.

Velcro for securing of posters on the poster panel will be provided.

Guidelines for Poster Presentation:

When submitting your Poster abstract, please follow the following instructions:

Each abstract should not exceed one A4-sized page.

The manuscript must be typed in font size 11, with line spacing of 1.15pt and at least one inch margin on both sides and bottom.

Please provide the title of lecture, name of author and name of department and institution followed by the abstract.

All posters to be presented in English only.

Title is to be printed at the top of the poster. (BOLD CAPITAL letters, Font: Times New Roman, Size: # 100).

Name (s) of author (s), institution (s), city and country of author (s) should be stated clearly, directly below the title. Provide the surname (s) of the author (s) followed by initials.

Print the name of the presenting author in bold.

All poster presenters are requested to adhere to the mount and tear down times.
